THE LETTER T

If you cross in the middle like...

If you cross two-thirds of the way up like...



You make long-term goals you can achieve with hard work, such as making an A on a test.

If you cross high or above the stem like...



You're a dreamer with very high goals, such as becoming President.

SHAPE

If your letters are big and bubbly like...



You're affectionate and like to hear you've done a good job. You often base your decisions on what feels right instead of just the facts.

If your letters are small and compact like...



You're smart and independent. You use logic to tackle problems and try to handle things yourself before asking for help.

SLANT

If your letters stand up straight like..



You like to think things through before acting and tend to keep your feelings to yourself.

If your letters lean to the right like..



You're outgoing and sociable, but if something's troubling you people are quick to notice.
