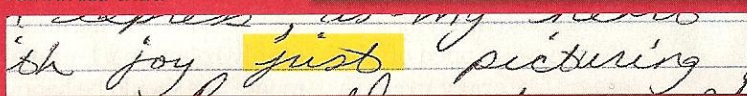
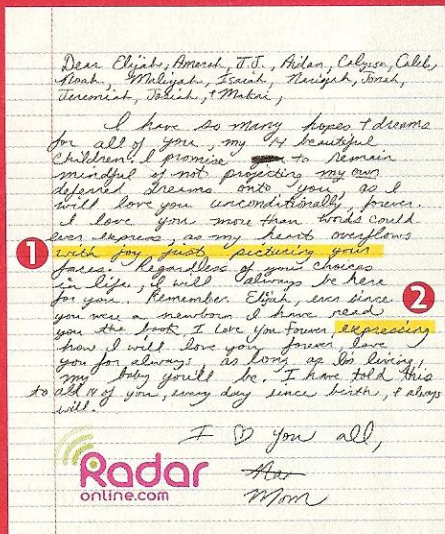


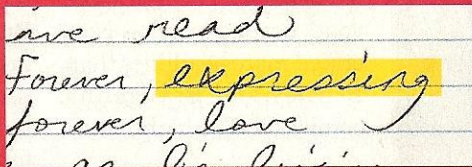
# Analyzing Her Letter

"It shows she has a strong need for closeness," Lowe says. Also of note: "When she writes some letters big, it means she's a person who doesn't like being told what to do, and the underlining of my own reinforces that."
